GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. The Entrance Examination for all the courses is in offline mode (Paper Pen based).
- 2. Candidate are requested to download the admit card from their login as per the schedule given in information brochure available at university website. No candidate is allowed to appear in the examination without admit card.
- 3. Candidates are required to report to the allotted test centre at least 30 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the test. No candidate will be allowed to appear in exam after the commencement of the test.
- 4. Candidates are to be in possession of the following when reporting to the test centre: (i) Admit Card (ii) Ball Point Pen (iii) Valid Photo ID Proof
- 5. Candidate who is found either copying or receiving assistance will be disqualified. Candidate offering assistance to other candidates will also be disqualified.
- 6. OMR sheet (Answer Sheet) and the question booklet will be taken back after completion of the exam by the Invigilator immediately. Candidate is no way, allowed to leave exam centre before the completion of the exam.
- 7. There will be no negative marking for wrong answers.
